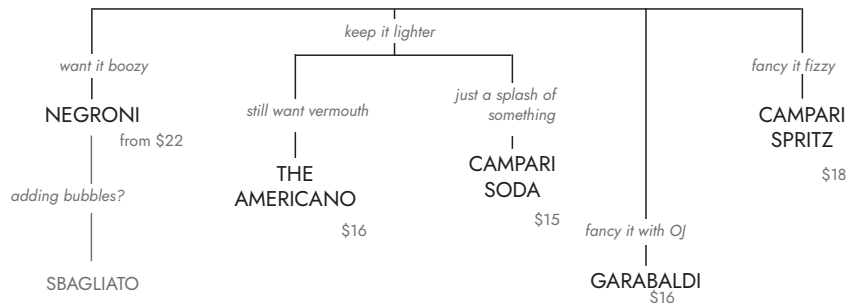
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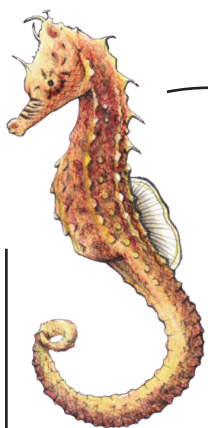
Apéritif is to the south of France as Sherry is to Spain, the spritz to Italy—a drink, yes, but also ritual in drink form, interwoven into the fabric of the culture. The ritual of drinking apertifs is rooted in everyday life in the south of France; The refreshing weight of a cool glass in hand is most at home in Provence, alongside a soundtrack of cicadas, pétanque and the sea in the distance, another summer day slowly unspooling. As obvious as its appeal is, this rite has not come close to securing the foothold that other European traditions have, despite having all of the ease and idiosyncrasy possessed by, say, the aperitivo cocktail. But it's ready for a second look, either as the ritual unadorned or easily upgraded.

Mauro's passion also extends to the base wine, which historically has been low quality table wines, however, these are crafted in his own winery from native Piedmontese varieties.

SHERRY & APERAS

EL MARCO + THE PALOMINO FINO CONTINUUM

The word Sherry has become problematic - to ask for a 'Sherry' doesn't tell if you are getting a wine that is white or dark, dry or sweet. This is El Marco and it starts with a range of dry white wines made from the Palomino grape, including those that are fortified and those that are not - hence the continuum. There are also dry, amber-coloured Palomino styles. These are fortified wines with a marked developmental character due to ageing: Amontillado, Oloroso, Palo Cortado. It is complex and often hard to understand, both in a literal and tasting sense - but trust the process and you'll be rewarded.

FUN FACTS

Pét-Nat is a term that's been hitting the headlines as of late, and while we are not the 'in' crowd, it seems to be what the cool kids are drinking. Simply put it's short for pétillant-naturel, also known as 'méthode ancestrale'. Well what does that mean? The wine is bottled before primary fermentation has finished, making these bubbles delicate, frivolous, fun and easy drinking.

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WORLDLY SPARKLING

VDP.SEKT.PRESTIGE:

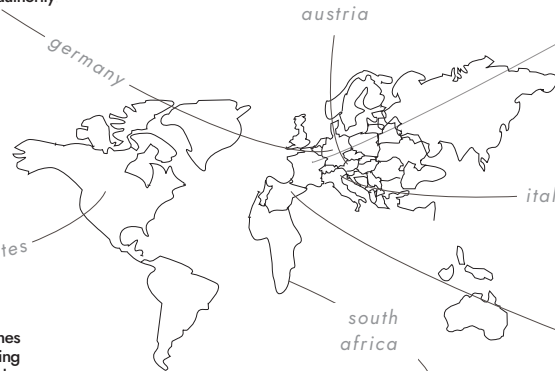
Germany has a long history of sparkling wine production with the first Sekt being produced in Württemberg in 1826. New laws proposed by the VDP stipulate a minimum of 36 months on lees and must be assessed by a national authority

AUSTRIAN SEKT:

becoming a legal category in 2016, this wine is not permitted to use a regional designation other than to say it is produced in Austria. All 36 varieties grown in the country can be used for Sekt production.

CRÉMANT

a French term for wine made with the same production method as Champagne without actually coming from the region of Champagne. Crémant can be made in seven regions in France (as well as bordering Luxembourg).



USA CHAMPAGNE & SPARKLING:

There are no laws for production of sparkling wines in the USA. Despite the term Champagne being legally protected, a loophole emerged when the United States did not properly ratify the treaty of Versailles in 1919. As a result a handful of producers are still permitted to have their wines labeled as "California Champagne".

PROSECCO:

from the Veneto in northeast Italy. Made from the grape formerly known as Prosecco, changing its name to Glera 2007. Unlike Champagne, Prosecco is produced using the Charmat method in which the secondary fermentation takes place in large stainless steel tanks.

CAVA:

classically from Penedès but can be produced elsewhere in Spain. Made in the 'traditional method' typically made with three Spanish varieties Macabeo, Parellada and Xarel.lo.

MÉTHODE CAP CLASSIQUE:

is the name for South African sparkling wine produced using the 'traditional method' adopted in 1992 in response to the ban on using the word Champagne. Predominantly made from Sauvignon Blanc or Chenin Blanc.

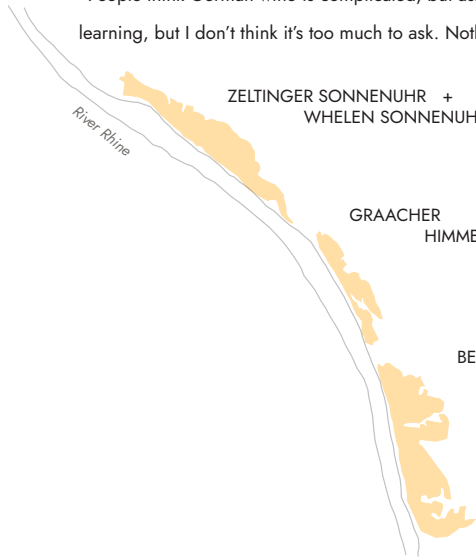

AROMATIC vs TEXTURAL

enter wine talk

When talking about aromatic and textural whites we often look for what is at the forefront of the wine.

Are there lifted florals or noticeable vibrant fruits driving the wine, hence displaying pronounced aromas. Or is the wine more about textural aspects that have a generosity and defined palate weight that can build a savory framework around the wine.

Now all that palava aside it is not to say that an aromatic wine cannot be textural or vice versa but more so that which is the leading playmaker in the glass.

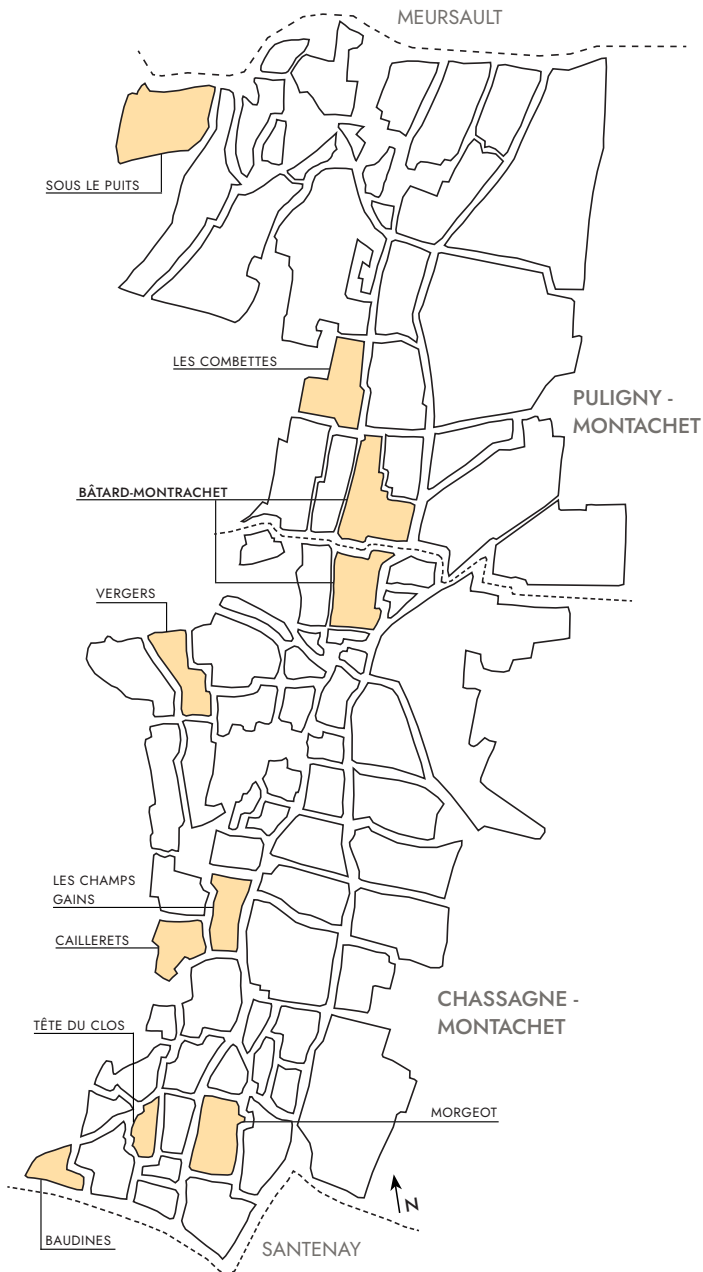

OREGON: AN EXPLORATION

"Everything you do up here must be about the quality of the grape. People tell you Pinot Noir is the most difficult wine to make, but that's a sound bite. What's true is that it's the most difficult grape to find a spot where it expresses its true identity. Once you find the perfect spot, it's just like making any other wine."

Though the Willamette Valley was officially established in 1983, the first vines were planted in 1965 when several California producers, particularly David Lett of Eyrie Vineyards, traveled north in search of cooler climates. The states pioneer's immediately saw ties between this region and Burgundy and producers got to work dividing the appellation into more specific subregions.

The states early grape growers planted Pinot Noir and Chardonnay because of their success in France — the Pinot was celebrated and is still seen as the crown jewel of the region however the Chardonnay didn't achieve the same status, likely due to poor clonal selection at the time. This perception changed when the area was introduced to the Dijon clone that thrived in cooler climates, producing wines of immense intensity and fruit weight.

There has always been a deep determination in the region to create compelling wines that speak of place and maker - the selection below is no exception.

A DEEP DIVE INTO THE PRODUCERS REDEFINING THE GOLDEN STATE

ARNOT-ROBERTS - LAKE DISTRICT

The focus of Arnot-Roberts is to produce distinctive, site-driven wines that highlight the nature of the unique terroirs. A collaboration between Nathan Roberts and Duncan Arnot Meyers. Nathan's father founded a cooperage in Napa, and his grandmother was Margrit Biever Mondavi, Robert's widow. The wines possess a beautiful textural quality, with attractive fruit but also lovely balance. They began making Trousseau in 2009, when they discovered the variety growing at the Luchsinger Vineyard. Trousseau thrives in the warm days and cool nights, a unique variety for its ability to make a wine that is light in colour but layered with complex flavour.

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MATTHIASSEN - NAPA VALLEY

Steve Matthiasson has a name that is not only easy to misspell but that is also legendary in Californian viticulture circles. He wrote the manual on sustainable vineyard practices in 1999, and for years consulted to wine heavyweights such as Stag's Leap Wine and Spottswoode. They have carved a tense, restrained Chardonnay that pulses with energy and texture but not weight. The Linda Vista Vineyard is next to the Matthiasson's house in West Oak Knoll. It's exposed site and cooling winds help maintain great acidity despite the Californian sun. Fermented and aged in old French oak but with no lees-stirring and only partial malolactic fermentation, the vibrant fruit holds sway.

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BIRICHINO - SANTA CRUZ

Drawing on decades of experience making wine in California, France and Italy, John Locke and Alex Krause founded Birichino in 08. They met in the early 90s while working at Bonny Doon and when it was sold, they left with a pick-up truck, one customer and a very vague plan. Things have snowballed since then Birichino now works with some of California's best old-vine vineyards, they have close relationships with 15 or so growers, mostly family-run operations. This punchy blend is comprised of old vine material dating back to 1886, all three grapes were fermented and treated individually to express the best attributes of each variety. In the winery, the artisanal blueprint is writ large across all the wines; Birichino does not want to *create* flavour but let their old vines and heathy soils do the talking.

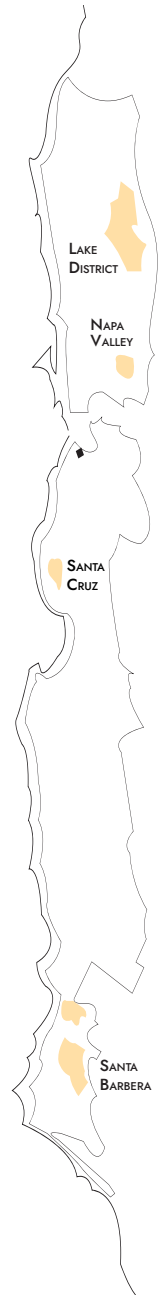

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PIEDRASASSI - SANTA BARBERA

Piedrasassi is a celebration of California's Central Coast, and though it may be known for its boisterous Chardonnay and world-class Cabernet, Piedrasassi chose to focus on a grape that speaks to the viticultural heritage of the Northern Rhone, Syrah. The turbulent hills of the Central Coast, shaped by tectonic contortion, are home to diverse soil types and when paired with the cooling influence of the nearby Pacific, create a truly unique and compelling home for Syrah. Bien Nacido is the oldest plantings that Piedrasassi hold, dating back to 1986. These older vines produce wines that show elegance and restrained tannin structure. Rim Rock is known for its intense florality, producing wines of immense power and depth and unofficially dubbed as the most iconic vineyard of Piedrasassi.

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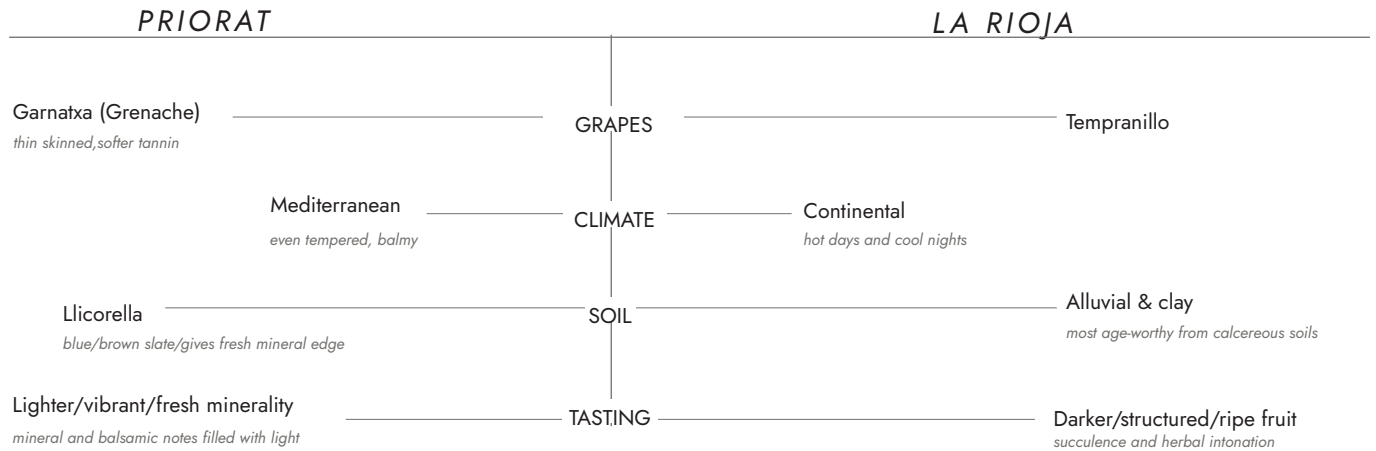

For example, Pinot Noir is a grape variety. Many people will use the word varietal when they really mean variety. Varietal is a descriptive term. The word is increasingly misused in place of variety. Varietal glassware and varietal labelling are describing the object.

E.g. Pinot Noir is a grape variety that should be served in varietal glassware.

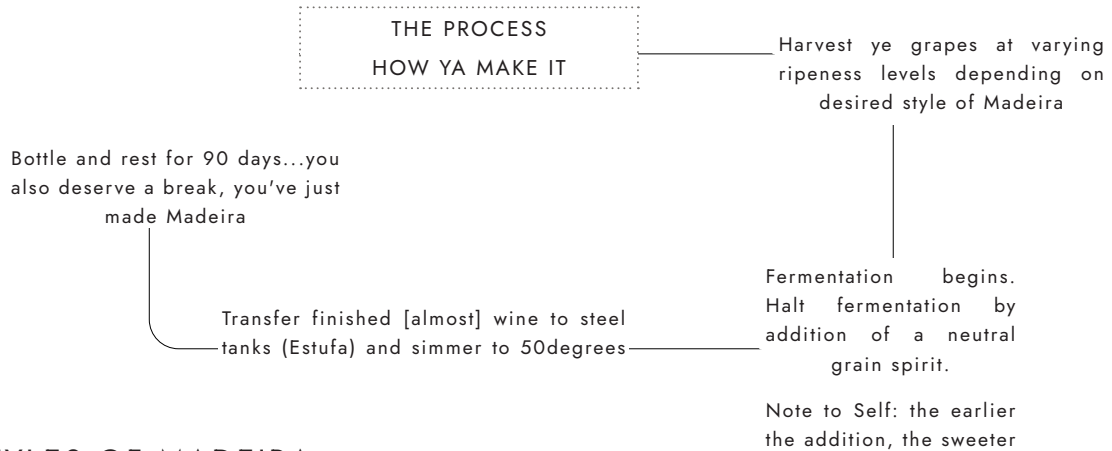
